

Section 3 – External Auditor Report and Certificate 2020/21

In respect of

Leysdown Parish Council – KE0161

1 Respective responsibilities of the body and the auditor

This authority is responsible for ensuring that its financial management is adequate and effective and that it has a sound system of internal control. The authority prepares an Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with *Proper Practices* which:

- summarises the accounting records for the year ended 31 March 2021; and
- confirms and provides assurance on those matters that are relevant to our duties and responsibilities as external auditors.

Our responsibility is to review Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with guidance issued by the National Audit Office (NAO) on behalf of the Comptroller and Auditor General (see note below). Our work **does not** constitute an audit carried out in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK & Ireland) and **does not** provide the same level of assurance that such an audit would do.

2 External auditor report 2020/21

Except for the matters reported below, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

The smaller authority has disclosed that it made proper provision during the year 2020/21 for the exercise of public rights, by answering 'Yes' to Section 1, Assertion 4. However, as was reported last year, we are aware that it failed to do this and therefore should have answered 'No' to this assertion. It has also disclosed that it took appropriate action on all matters raised in reports from internal and external audit, by answering 'Yes' to Section 1, Assertion 7, which, on the basis of the above, is not correct.

The smaller authority has not addressed the 'except for' matters raised by the external auditor when qualifying the prior year annual return. Section 2, Box 7 for the prior year does not agree to Boxes 1+2+3-(4+5+6). This is as a result of an error in the prior year Box 6 figure. Section 2, Box 6 for the prior year should read £27,950 and the Box 1 restatement detailed below.

Section 2, Box 1 for the prior year has been restated, the smaller authority confirmed this was an error. Prior year Box 1 should read £35,409.

Other matters not affecting our opinion which we draw to the attention of the authority:

The smaller authority has not provided:

- an adequate explanation for the variance between the prior and current year values in Box 3 of Section 2

We note that the smaller authority did not comply with Regulation 15 of the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 as it failed to make proper provision during the year 2021/22 for the exercise of public rights, since the approval date was after the start of the period for the exercise of public rights. As a result, the smaller authority must answer 'No' to Assertion 4 of the Annual Governance Statement for 2021/22 and ensure that it makes proper provision for the exercise of public rights during 2022/23.

The authority has repaid £10,000 in respect of grant paid in error received in the year and accounted for it in Box 6 rather than netting it against the relevant receipt. Whilst the Practitioners' Guide is silent on the matter, it is our view that the true income to the authority should be shown on a net basis. Accounting on a gross basis inflates the gross income and gross expenditure of the authority and can push the authority into a higher fee band than it would otherwise be in.
